Black Creek Township received \$55,997.47 from Luzerne County for the reimbursement of the material purchased for the Tower Road Bridge Project.

Recycling: A letter was received in the morning from Solomon Container Services that recycling for single stream will increase to \$195 per haul and \$32 per ton on April 9th. The township can switch to single stream at a cost of \$195 per haul with no fee per ton; glass no longer accepted.

Public Comment:

Ted Sherock- Asked when the guide railing will be installed on the Tower Road Box Culvert. Rohrbach met with Luzerne County approximately one month ago, at which time they were planning on installing the guide railing the following week, weather permitting. Suggested the township consider taking newspaper from the recycling center to the Carmelite Nuns.

Engineer Dan Durange- Eagle Rock Open Space Subdivision: Can supervisors approve the Eagle Rock Subdivision, possibly through a special meeting. Durange asked for conditional approval, based in the attorney's review of the comments. The supervisors did not yet receive the review from Brinkash and Associates and did not feel comfortable approving the project.
