A regular meeting of the Black Creek Township Supervisors was called to order.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The floor was opened for Public Comment on agenda items only with a five minute time limit.

There were no additions or corrections to the minutes of the previous meeting, therefore, a motion was made by Donald Nenstiel, seconded by Bonnie Adams to dispense with the reading of the minutes and approve the minutes as presented. Roll Call Vote: Donald Nenstiel yes and Bonnie Adams yes.

The Financial Report was postponed due to the absence of Secretary-Treasurer Dennis Feerrar.

Donald Nenstiel made a motion seconded by Bonnie Adams to approve payment of the bills as presented. Roll Call Vote: Donald Nenstiel yes and Bonnie Adams yes.

The following correspondence was received from: Luzerne County and they will be holding a Storm Water Management Meeting on February 8, Luzerne County Office of Community Development stating that we were allotted \$110,000.00 for Road Improvements in 2010 and a complaint from a concerned citizen about the shooting range.

The Engineer gave his report on items he is working on.

The Solicitor reported that he is working on drafts of the SALDO – Zoning Ordinance and the Code Ordinance.

The Zoning – Code Officer gave his report. He is working on complaints.

The Fire Chief Joseph Lescowitch gave his report.

Bonnie Adams gave a Road Department and the Recreation Committee Report.

The ambulance report was given.

Under Old Business:

It was announced that the Resignation of Auditor Regina Planutis was accepted and George Larock was appointed to fill her position at a Special Meeting held on January 26.

Under New Business:

Act 32 EIT Collections will start in 2012. The County needs \$50,000.00 for this but for now it will cost Black Creek Township \$100.00. Donald Nenstiel made a motion seconded by Bonnie Adams to give them \$100.00. Roll Call Vote: Donald Nenstiel yes and Bonnie Adams yes.

The Nuremberg Library is now open.
