A regular meeting of the Black Creek Township Supervisors was called to order.

The floor was opened for Public Comment on Agenda items only with a five minute time limit.

There was no Public Comment on Agenda items.

The Solicitor Reported that he is working on codifying the Township Ordinances and he is going to review the Personnel Policies and he is currently working on the issue with the Sewer Authority and the road conditions in Weston.

The Zoning Officer handed in one Building Permit that was issued in February.

Bonnie Adams gave a Recreation Committee Report and the Easter Egg Hunt will be held on April 4.

It was reported that an executive session will be held after the meeting on pending litigation.

Under Old Business:

The Website should be set up by April.

Also the Delinquent Street Light and Per Capita taxes were sent in to Don Wilkinson Agency.

Under New Business:

QuickBooks has been installed into our computer and we will have someone come in and train us on Municipal Accounting.

We are working on setting up a recycling center for the township and applying for grants.

As request by Todd Eachus, we now have a 5-Year plan. We have an eight member committee that helped compile this list.

Scott Weller asked if Donald Nenstiel was called to drive snowplow since he has a CDL.

A discussion was held on how the roads were taken care of this year.

Lori Webster feels that the Supervisors have made a good effort and the roads have been better.

Gerry Gottstien complained about how the alley to his house was messed up and needs to be corrected. Supervisors will look at it soon.

Sam Red had issues with Bonnie Adams and Dennis Feerrar ignoring Donald Nenstiel . Bonnie Adams responded that he said he didn't want to be bothered and was going to resign.

Julia Maczuga asked about fixing the ditch on Gross Road.

Joyce Knies thanked the Supervisors for making the effort to fix Tower Road and it's a real good start. However, lots of work still needs to be done.

Ralph Brutosky had a statement to make that the Supervisors should check the qualifications of people they appoint.
