**REGULAR MEETING**

A regular meeting of the Black Creek Township Supervisors was called to order.

Members present were: Bonnie Adams, Donald Nenstiel, and Dennis Feerrar.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The floor was opened for Public Comment on agenda items only with a five minute time limit.

Scott Weller had comments on the financial reports - Ratification of the bills and when they were approved and what kind of budget will be submitted. Dennis Feerrar replied it is a -0- Base Budget. He also asked about reports at the meeting.

There were no additions or corrections to the minutes of the previous meeting, therefore, a motion was made by Dennis Feerrar, seconded by Donald Nenstiel to dispense with the reading of the minutes and approve the minutes as presented. Roll Call Vote: Donald Nenstiel yes, Dennis Feerrar yes, and Bonnie Adams yes.

Dennis Feerrar gave a financial report with the total available funds at \$206,499.87.

Donald Nenstiel made a motion seconded by Dennis Feerrar to ratify the bills as presented. Roll Call Vote: Donald Nenstiel yes, Dennis Feerrar yes, and Bonnie Adams yes.

Under Old Business:

It was reported that 252 tires were delivered to Butler Township for recycling.

The Solicitor announced that Penn Wind resubmitted paperwork for their Land Development Plan and also he acquired a new township seal for us since ours broke and a new Law Book for the Supervisors.

Under New Business:

A Yamulla Sub-Division was submitted to the County and DEP for comments. After receiving these comments and reviewing them, the Engineer suggested we approve it. Dennis Feerrar made a motion to approve it, seconded by Donald Nenstiel. Roll Call Vote: Donald Nenstiel yes, Dennis Feerrar yes, and Bonnie Adams yes.

It was reported that the 2010 Community Development Grant was submitted and a survey of surrounding residents that will benefit from these improvements will be done as the next step.

Donald Nenstiel made a motion to approve the 2010 MMO. Bonnie Adams second. Roll Call Vote: Donald Nenstiel yes, Dennis Feerrar yes, and Bonnie Adams yes.

Bonnie Adams announced that the Fireman's Relief check was received and distributed and a donation of \$2,500.00 will be given to them at the next meeting.

Bonnie Adams made a motion for Dennis Feerrar to start to work on the 2010 Budget, Donald Nenstiel second. Roll Call Vote: Donald Nenstiel yes, Dennis Feerrar yes, and Bonnie Adams yes.

The next meeting will be held on November 4, 2009.

Under Public Comment:

Joseph Cassidy commented on the Zoning Hearing Board and the Wind Mill Hearing that was held on October 22, 2009, for an extension for completion. He also had issues concerning the purchase of the Wind Mill equipment coming from a foreign country.

Carl Rittenhouse expressed his feeling concerning the fact that Dave Yamulla is bringing in the Wind Mills and even though they are a necessary evil – they will be bringing in money to the township.

Leon Fontain suggested that the Supervisors should not take these issues to heart but these people want answers and they are not getting them.

Donald Nenstiel made a motion to adjourn. Dennis Feerrar second.
