KEVIN WALSH GAVE TOWNSHIP LEASE FOR FOOD PANTRY, JOE MADE MOTION TO APPROVE THE LEASE, BONNIE SECOND, ROLL CALL ADAMS YES, FEERRAR YES, LESCOWITCH YES. GARY ROHBACH ON BRIDGE ON TOWER ROAD, THOUGH OUR PEOPLE WOULD DO THE WORK. PROJECT TO COST APPROX \$130,000 DOLLARS, AND WILL BE DONE BY OUTSIDE CONTRACTOR. THAT IS WHY WE ARE APPLYING FOR A MULTIMODAL GRANT.
